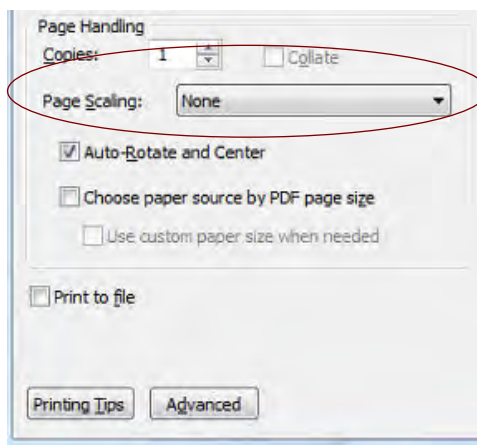


I'm excited you decided to make my Eiffel Tower Piñata! Please send me pictures to feature on my blog and Facebook page!!

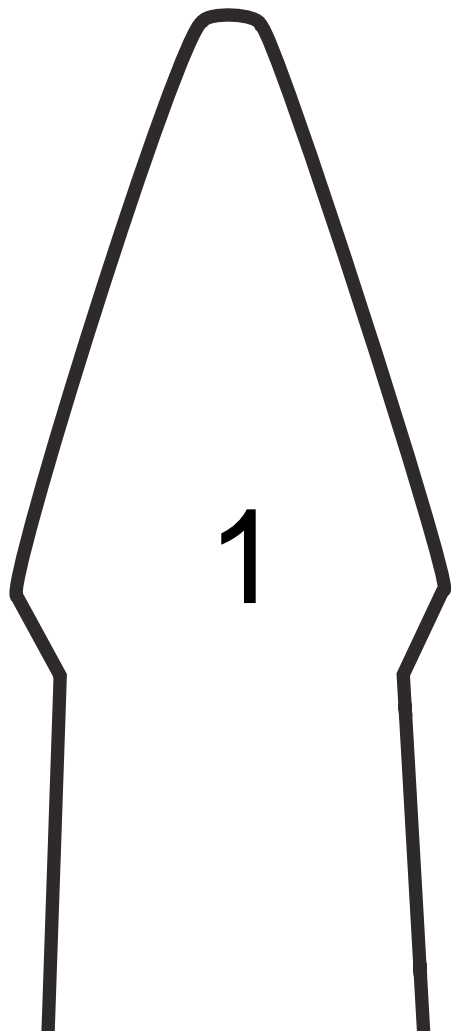


Once taped, cut the shape of the Eiffel Tower and trace it on 4 pieces of cardboard.
