

Cute Hanging Bat

Materials needed:

1 sheet of 8.5" x 11" paper per bat

Scissors

Stick glue

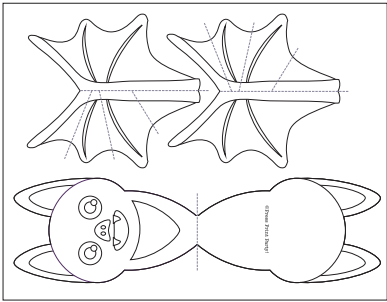
String

Ruler

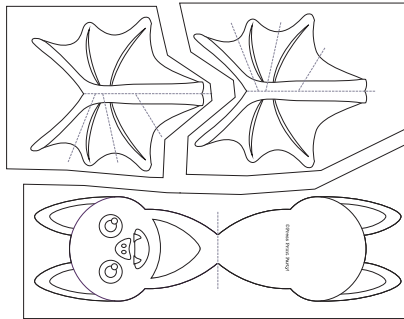
Something blunt to score the paper like a butter knife, big paper clip, or bone folder.

Instructions:

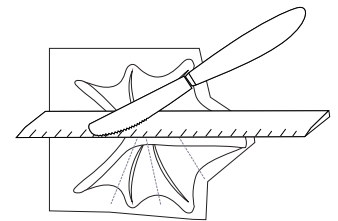
1 Print the page



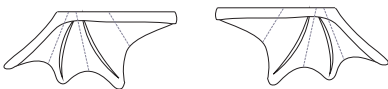
2 Roughly cut around the wings and bat



3 Score the middle of the wings and bat



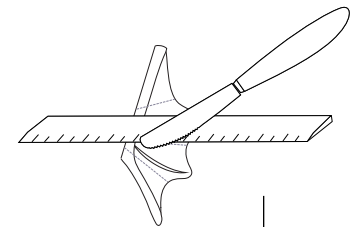
4 Fold the wings in half, glue, cut on the inside white lines



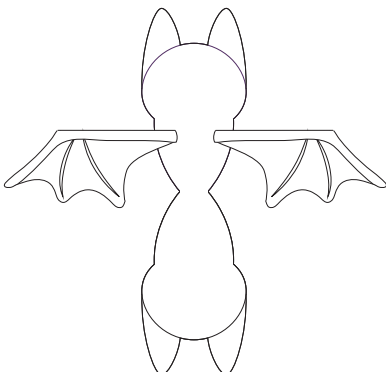
5 Fold the bat in half, DO NOT GLUE. Line up the front and back up by putting light behind the paper and adjusting the fold. Cut on the inside white line



6 Score on the dashed lines on the wings and fold like an accordion



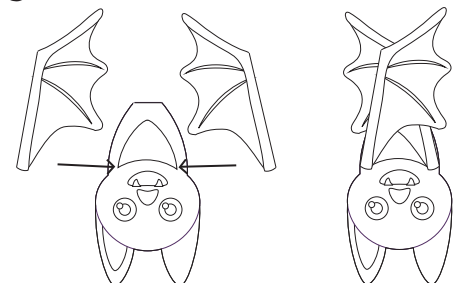
7 Open the bat's body and glue the wings as shown on the inside

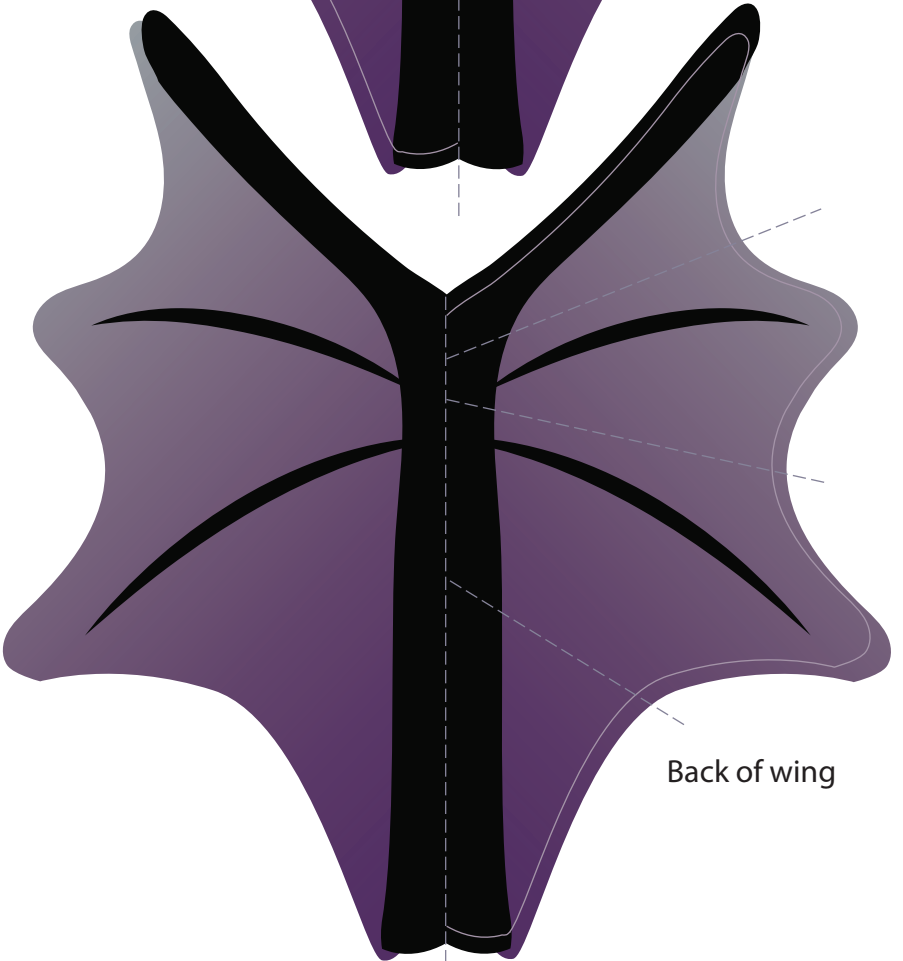
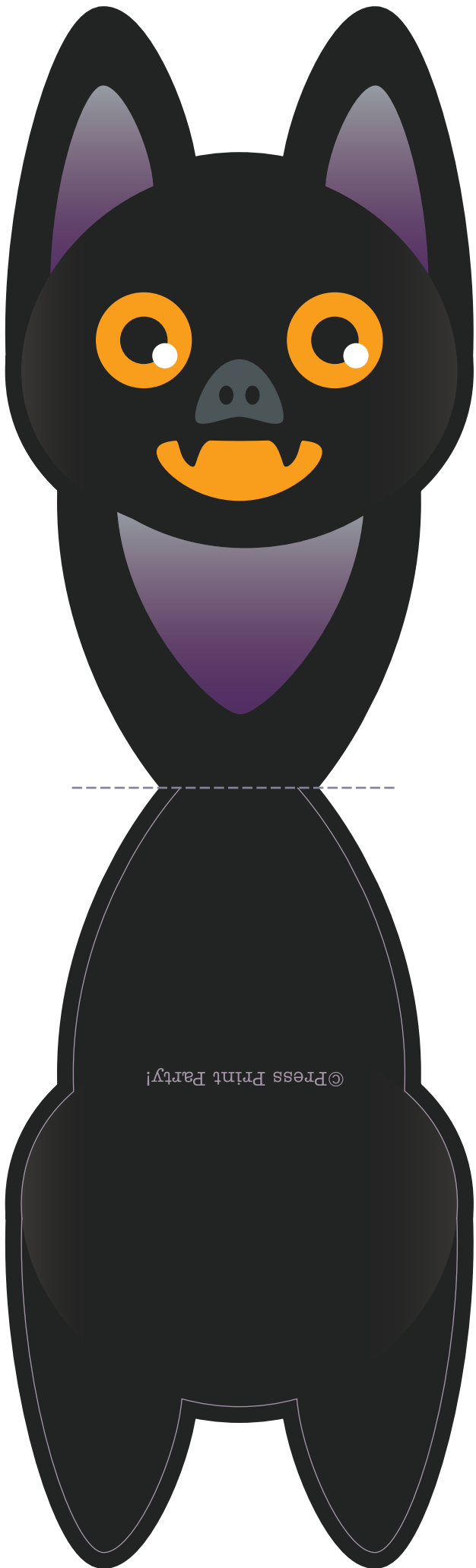


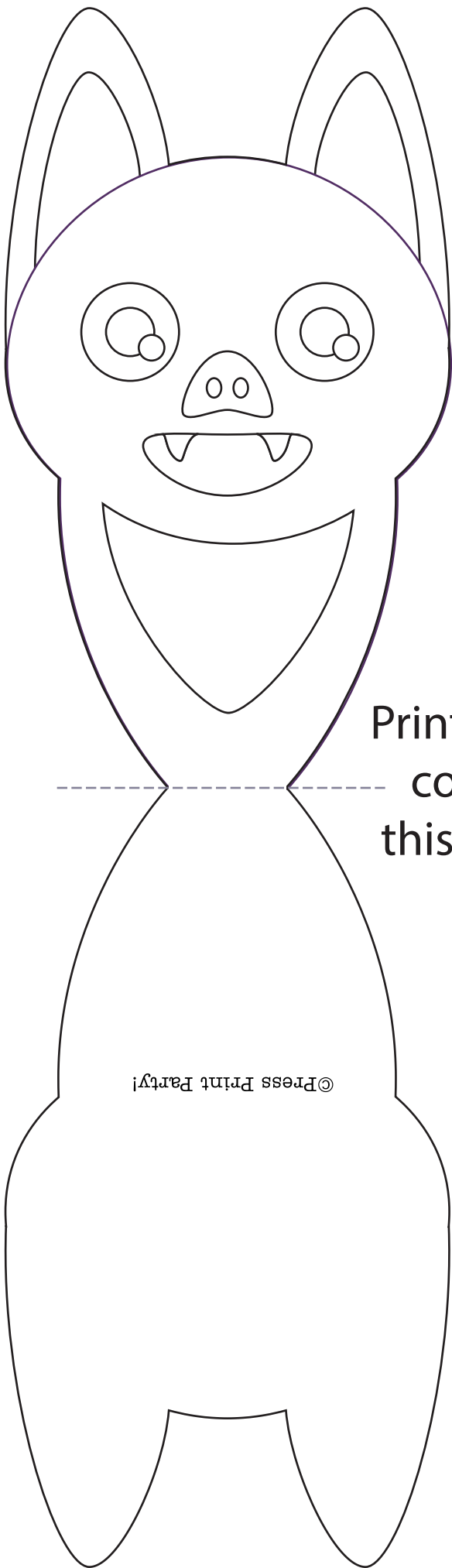
8 Fold and glue the body. Punch a hole in the top and hang with string



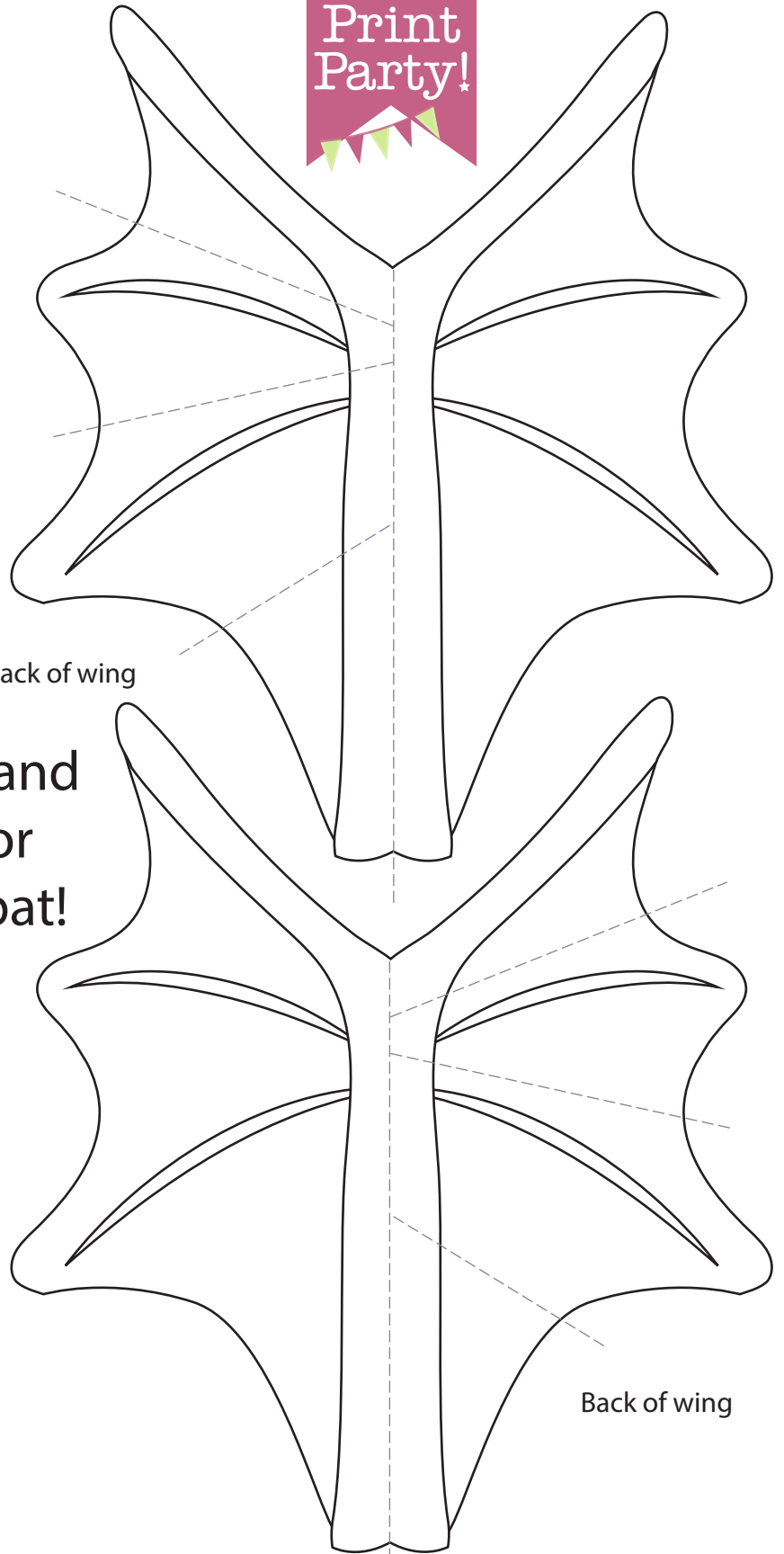
9 To make an upside down bat, glue the body together first then glue the wings on top of the body as shown:
