## Fields and Fonts

This pdf contains several fields for you to personalize your printables. If you're experiencing trouble with the type not centering, **make sure you're using the latest version of Adobe Reader 65 to open this file.** You may download it here <http://get.adobe.com/reader/>

If you're on a Mac and still experiencing trouble in Reader after opening the file in Mac Viewer, you'll need to re-download the file. Mac Viewer will corrupt pdf files with fields.

There is no need to download any fonts to use with this pdf file.

## Scoring

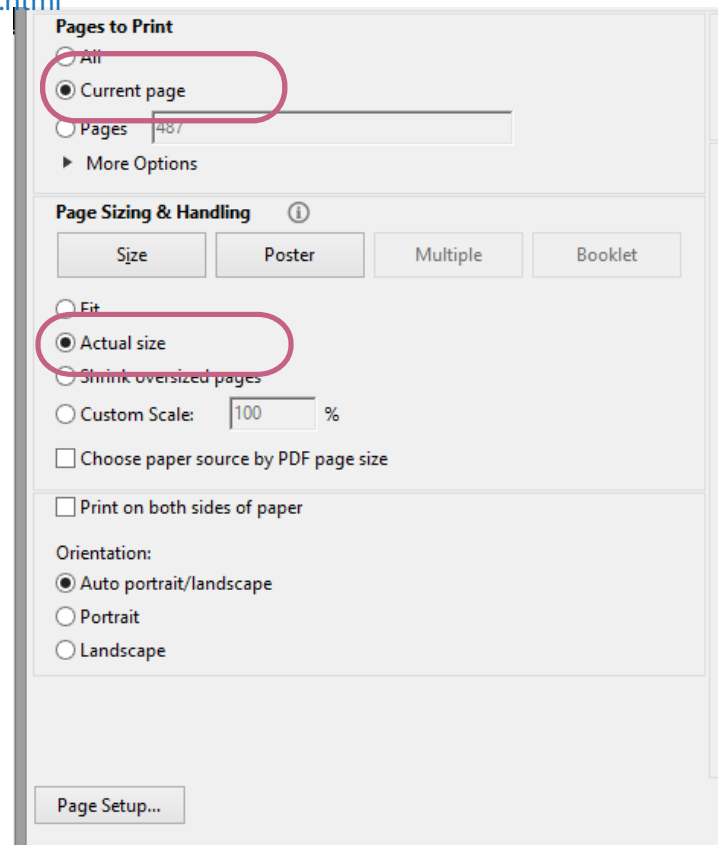
Scoring is the act of creating a line or depression in the paper that will help the paper fold. As paper gets heavier it is increasingly harder to fold. Therefore you must score the paper before folding and sometimes before even cutting out the item. ## Printing

- \* Experiment with your printer's print quality. You should get good results printing at Standard Quality. But you may want to print at the highest quality available for your printer.
- \* Set your **Page Sizing to Actual Size** in the Printer's dialog box. You may get an error message. Just ignore it.
- \* Since this pdf contains many pages make sure you set your print options to print: **Current page**.
- \* If you are having trouble with parts of the design (not the instructions) not printing around the edges, it means your printer has wide margins. Just adjust the print setting to fit to paper. This is not recommended for cards.

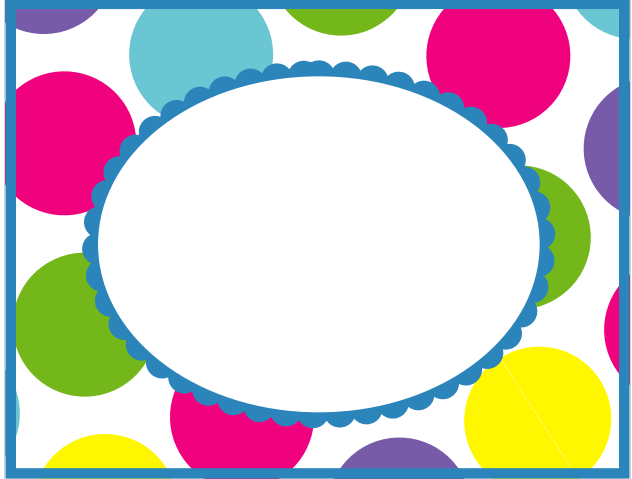
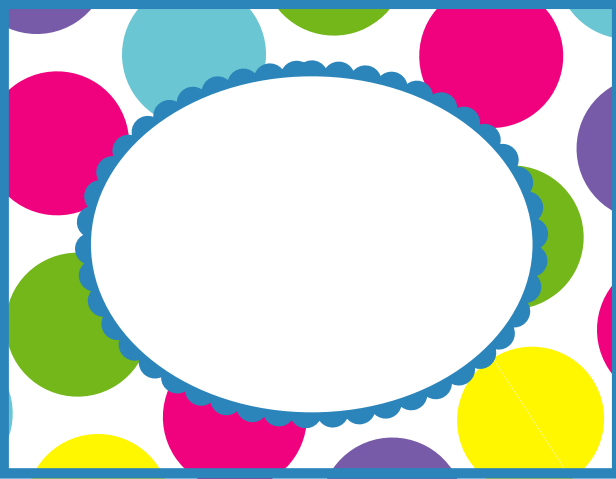
# Place Cards

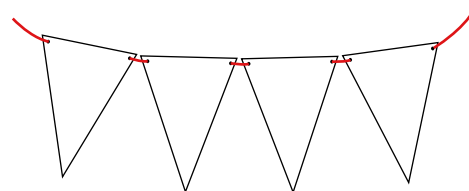
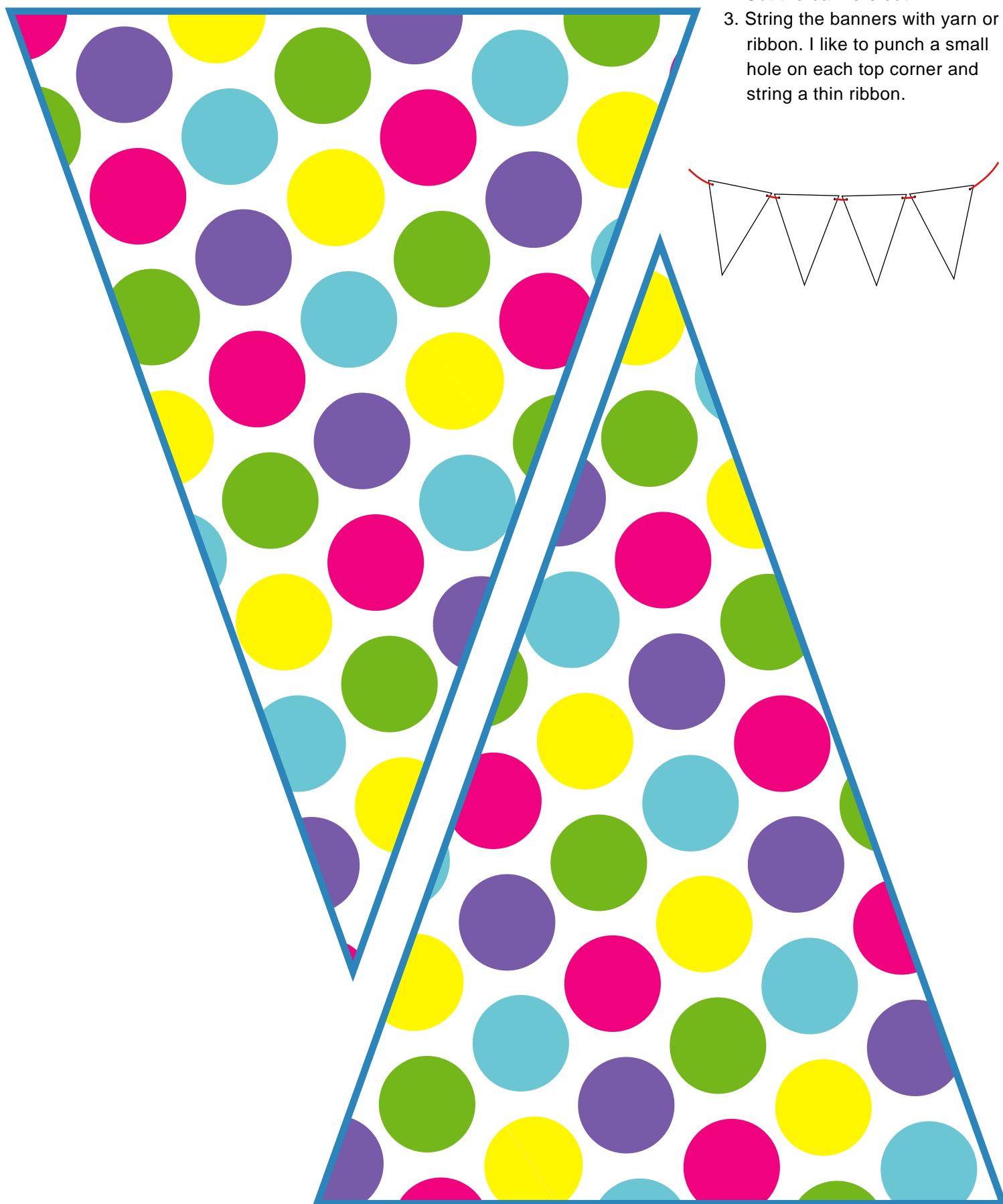

# Triangle banner

## Instructions

1. Print the page on white paper or cardstock.
2. Cut the banners out.
3. String the banners with yarn or ribbon. I like to punch a small hole on each top corner and string a thin ribbon.

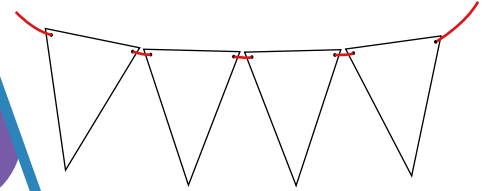


# Triangle banner

Letters/Numbers

## Instructions

1. Type one number or uppercase letter of your choice in each banner - 2 lower case letters can be used to make "th" or "rd".
2. Print the page on white paper or cardstock.
3. Repeat 1 and 2 until you have all the letters you need.
4. Cut the banners out.
5. String the banners with yarn or ribbon. I like to punch a small hole on each top corner and string a thin ribbon.



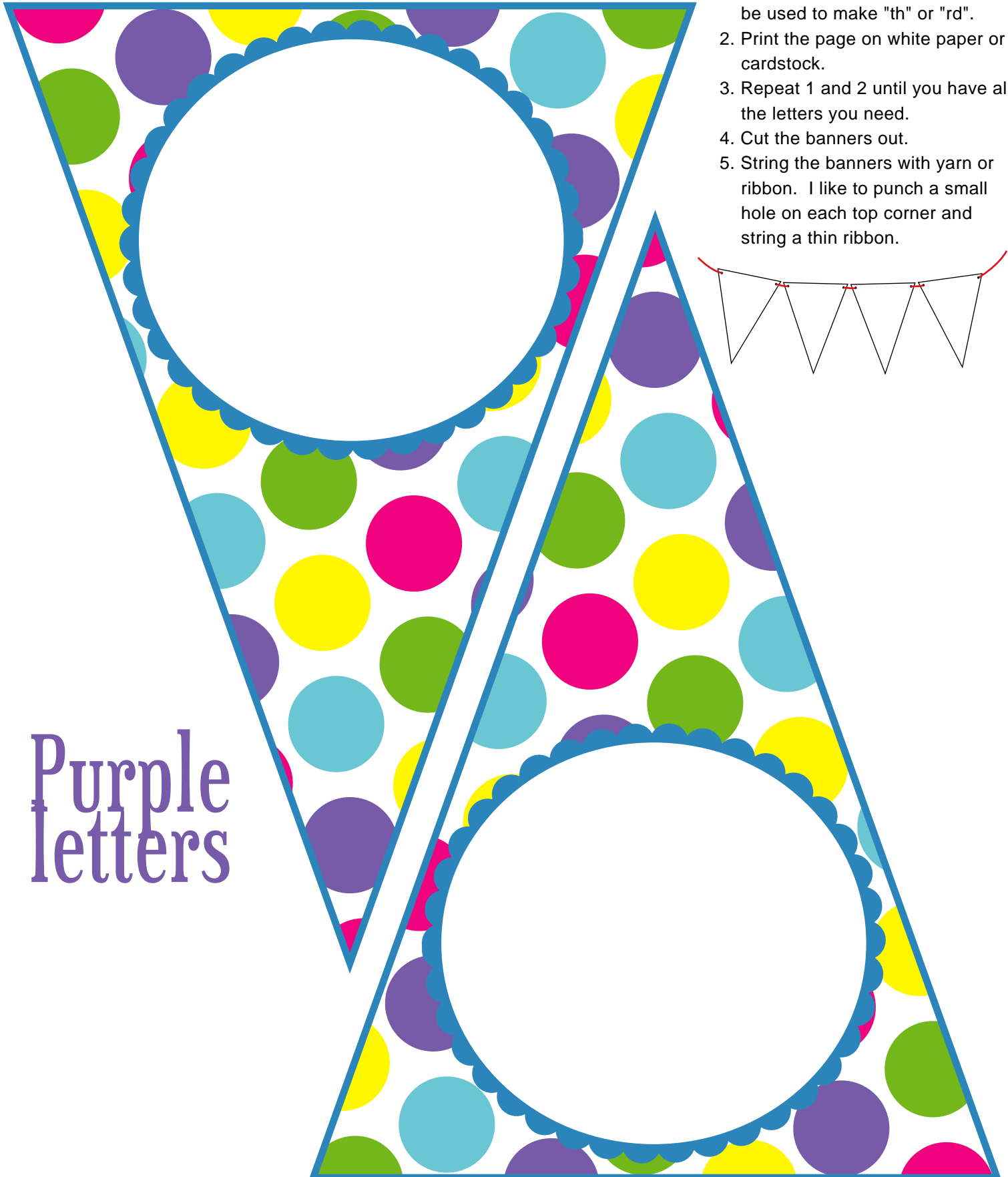

# Triangle banner

Letters/Numbers

## Instructions

1. Type one number or uppercase letter of your choice in each banner - 2 lower case letters can be used to make "th" or "rd".
2. Print the page on white paper or cardstock.
3. Repeat 1 and 2 until you have all the letters you need.
4. Cut the banners out.
5. String the banners with yarn or ribbon. I like to punch a small hole on each top corner and string a thin ribbon.

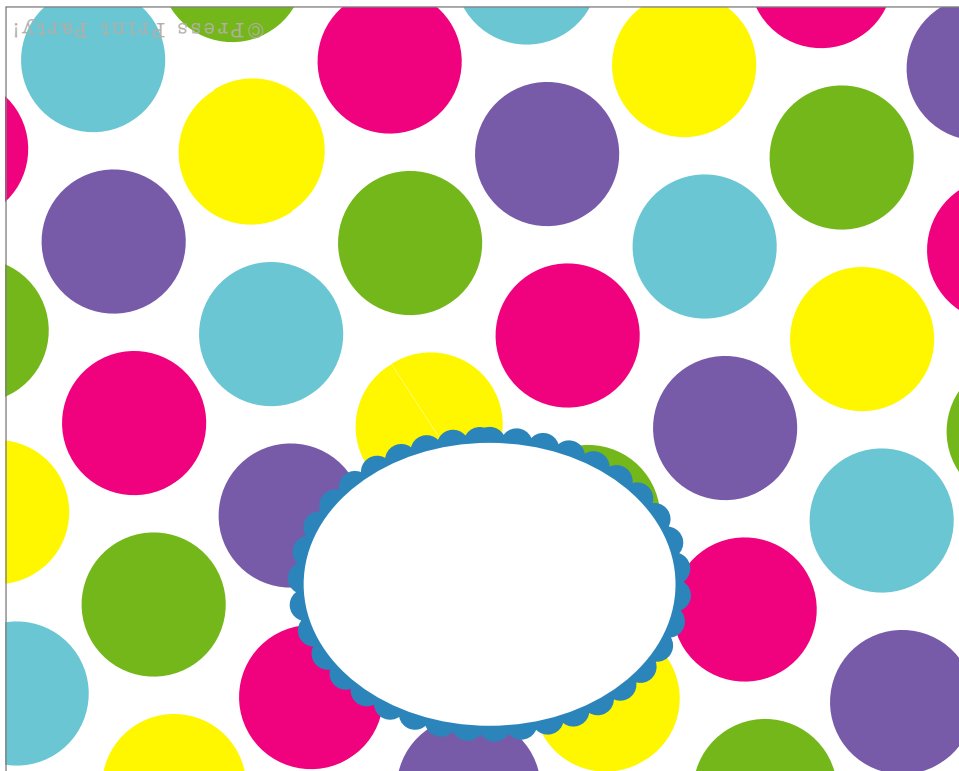

# Gift Bag Handles

## Instructions

1. Type your text in the text boxes.
2. Print the page on cardstock (110lb)
3. Cut the outline of the handles.
4. Score and fold.
5. Staple on top of clear favor bags or resealable bags.

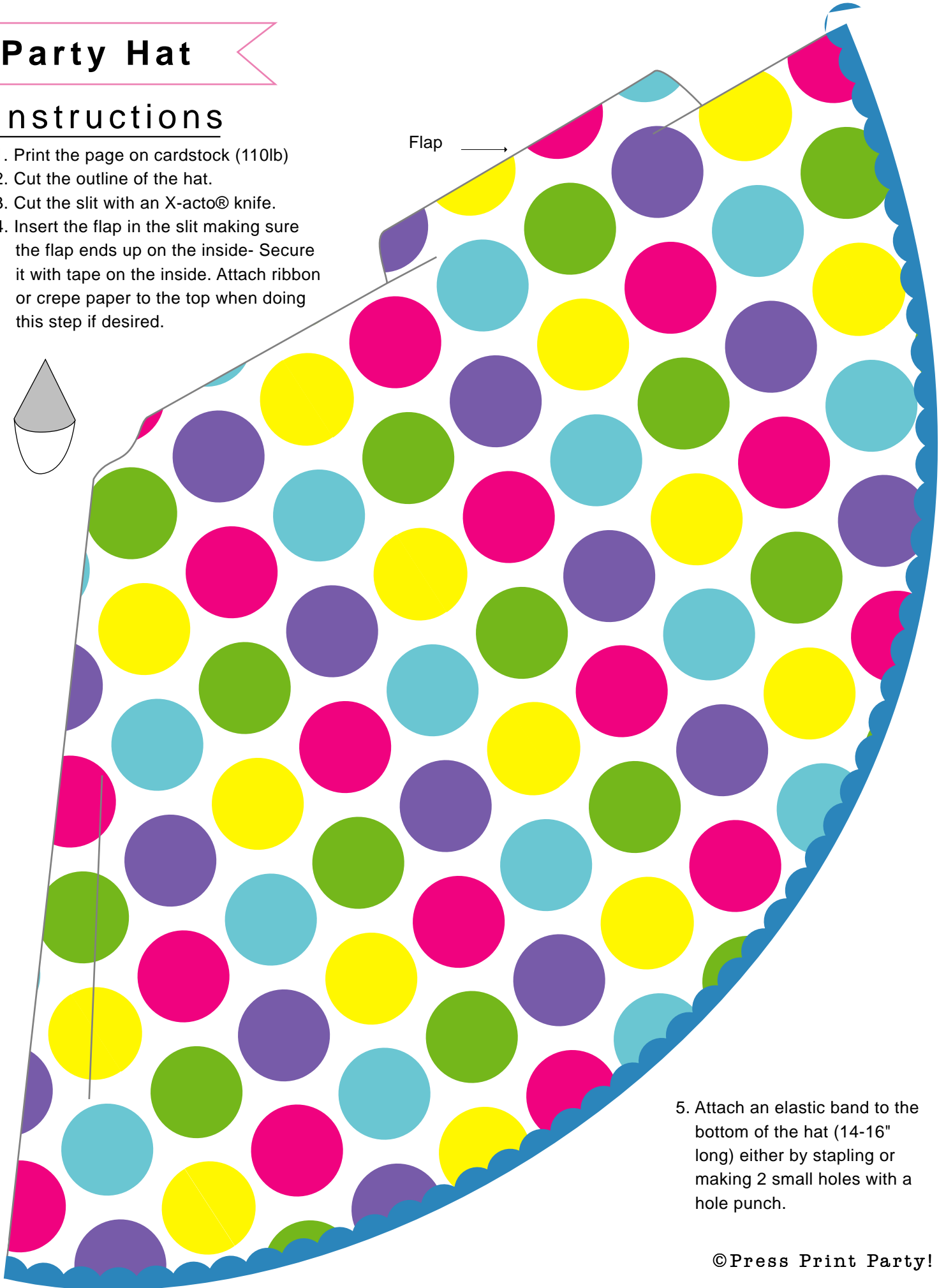
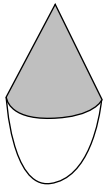


# Party Hat

## Instructions

1. Print the page on cardstock (110lb)
2. Cut the outline of the hat.
3. Cut the slit with an X-acto® knife.
4. Insert the flap in the slit making sure the flap ends up on the inside- Secure it with tape on the inside. Attach ribbon or crepe paper to the top when doing this step if desired.

Flap

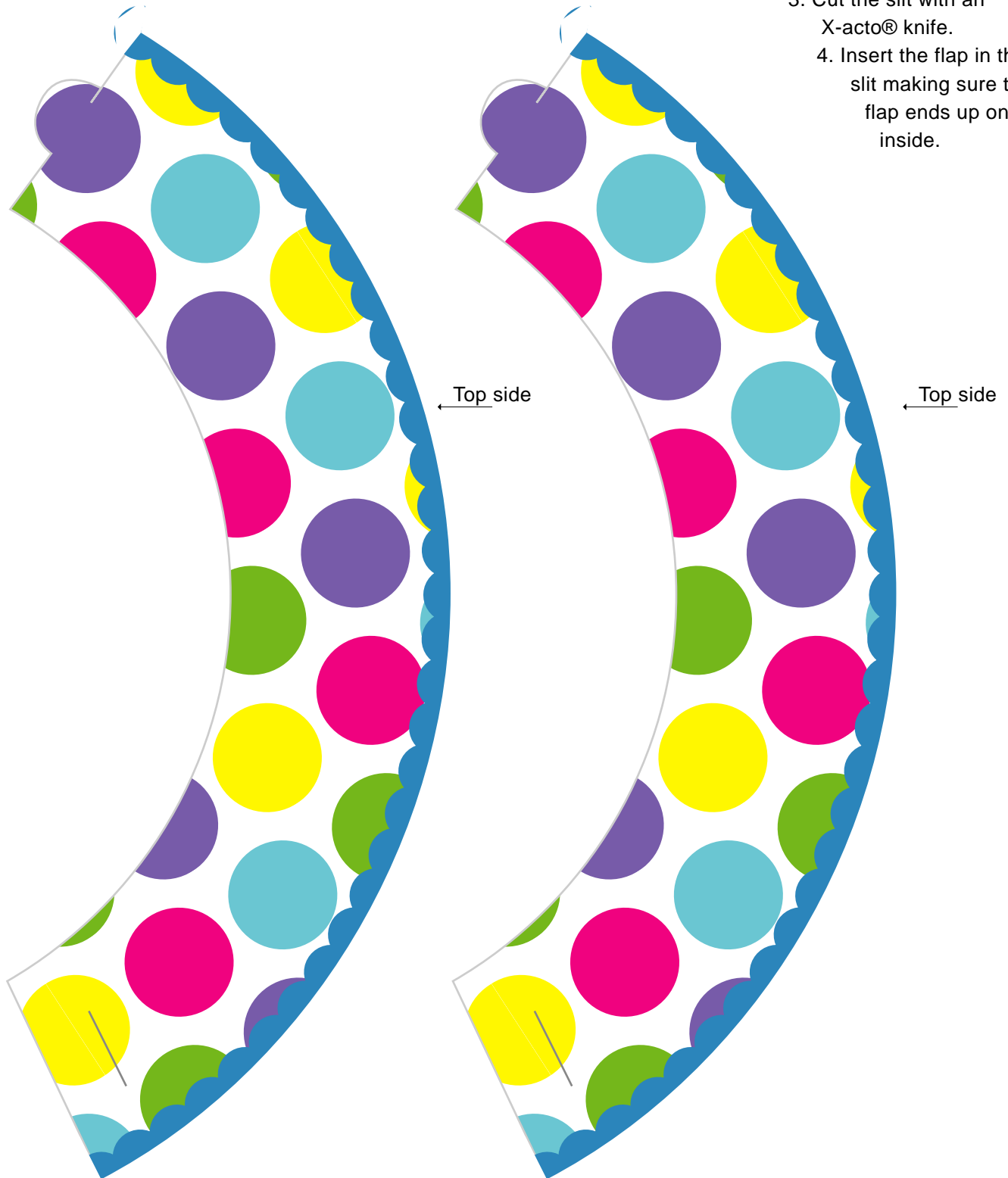


5. Attach an elastic band to the bottom of the hat (14-16" long) either by stapling or making 2 small holes with a hole punch.

# Cupcake Wrappers

## Instructions

1. Print the page on cardstock or good quality white paper.
2. Cut the outline of the wrapper using scalloped edged scissors for the top (long side) if desired.
3. Cut the slit with an X-acto® knife.
4. Insert the flap in the slit making sure the flap ends up on the inside.

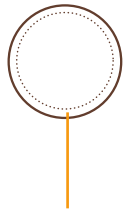




# Cupcake Toppers

## Instructions

1. Print the page on regular paper.
3. Cut out each circle with a 2 inch round punch.
4. Tape them on a toothpick or use them as confetti around the table.
